THE exterior of Wakefield College's Radcliffe Building is getting a £3m transformation.

Bardsley Construction Yorkshire has secured the contract, which will also provide new teaching space with an extension to the fifth floor. The Leeds-based division of Bardsley Construction will revamp the exterior of the 1960s building through a combination of insulated render, trespa cladding and glazing.

The new mix of materials designed by architects IBI Taylor Young will replace the current facade of the five-storey Radcliffe Building at the College's city centre campus, including the construction of a roof-top extension to form a new science block.

The works to the occupied five storey college will involve stripping the full external envelope cladding and replacing the external wall with an SFS walling system, new curtain walling / windows and a mixture of render and trespa board cladding, the new roof top extension will be constructed of lightweight steelwork and clad with similar materials, fully fitted out to form science labs. The college will remain fully operational during our works.
