## Yarn Street, Hunslet, Leeds, LS10 1NY

On the fringes of central Leeds, the h2010 development brings a range of exciting, high quality accommodation to an area brimming with opportunity.

It was built in 1838 by William Fairbairn, who also designed Armley Mills and Salts Mill at Saltaire. The mill owner was John Wilkinson who, by 1847, was employing 1500 female flax reelers. It was the last and the largest of the flax-spinning mills to be built in Leeds throughout that period. Demolition of the west range took place in 1986. The mill has 25 bays fronting the River Aire and 3 bays fronting Goodman Street.

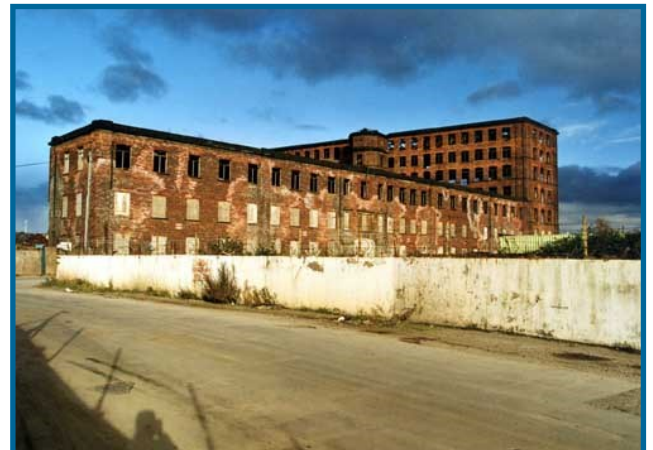
Now host to a new, mixed residential complex, 'h2010' by Miller Homes.
